Welcome and Greetings to the 2019 San Francisco Fringe Festival Community, as we celebrate our 28th Year!



FRINGE HOW-TO'S

BUY IN ADVANCE \$15.99 or less at www.theexit.org/fringe and be guaranteed a seat.

BUY AT THE DOOR \$13 or less at the door on a first-come, first-served basis starting 30 minutes before the show for available tickets. CASH ONLY/ limit 4 tickets per person.

BUY A FREQUENT FRINGER PASS see five shows for \$45, 10 for \$85. Available for sale in the Green Room at the EXIT, 156 Eddy Street, during Fringe hours. Frequent Fringer passes are good for discounted tickets but do not guarantee a seat, so be sure to get to the box office early to redeem your pass for a ticket. Each pass is good for one ticket per show and only for the cardholder.
